This report card will cover the period from November 6 th to February 19 th and will count for 20% of the final mark for the year. For Term 2, the teacher communicates a mark expressed as a percentage that reflects the knowledge and subject-specific competencies that a student has acquired, based on the evaluations carried out during the term.

Third Report Card	The third report card will be sent home on June 30 th . It will cover the period from February 19 th to June 11 th .
