Put on your light blue clothes, blue accessories and all your autism awareness gear!!

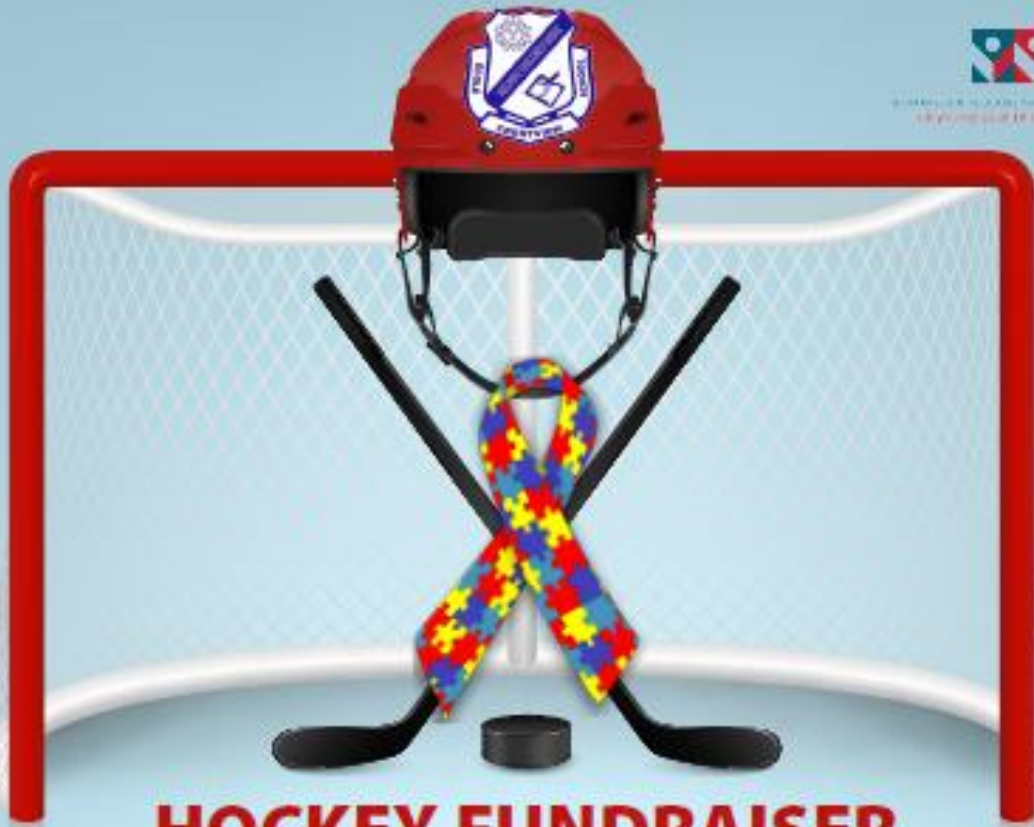

In order to ensure the safety of our students the following change, to pick-up, was implemented March 26th.

If you must pick-up your child early, or make a change to their pick-up, it must be written in your child's agenda. If you must make a last-minute change please contact our School Secretary, Ms. Claire, before 1:00 p.m. Students can no longer be picked up at the office without prior notification. Pick-up after 3:00 p.m. is strongly discouraged.

If your child attends daycare:

Daycare services are from 6:45 a.m. to 8:55 a.m. and from 3:35 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Parents may pick-up their child starting at 4:00 p.m., this will allow the buses to leave and to ensure that all students are accounted for.

If your child is a sporadic daycare user and you require services on an unscheduled day you must speak with Maria Soulis to confirm the change.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation in helping to keep our students learning in a safe environment.



### **Spring is Coming...**

The weather is getting warmer but our yard is still full of snow and slush and we ask that our students continue to wear **snow pants or splash pants and boots** until the yard is dry. Extra clothes at school are requested! It is very uncomfortable to spend an afternoon in wet pants and socks.



### **Drop-Off in the Morning**

School starts at 9:13 AM. This means that students are entering the school as of 8:55 AM and must be in class by 9:03 AM. The gate being used for student drop-off will continue to be closed at 9:00 AM.

### **Punctuality**

All students are expected to be on time for school every day. When students are late, they miss out on important instruction and it is very disruptive to the teacher and to the other students. Students who arrive late to school must wait at the office until the next period to reduce the disruption.

### **Forgotten items**

Please note that students are not permitted to call home for any forgotten items such as indoor shoes, homework, forms, etc. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate these requests as there are many other important tasks that we must attend to ensure a smooth functioning of the day. The only exception is for a forgotten lunch.

### **Calendar Changes**

In order to have the prescribed 180 teaching days and making up for the two days of cancelled class; **May 11<sup>th</sup>** and **June 8<sup>th</sup>** will now be regular school days.



If your child(ren) will be absent from school please call our School Secretary at (450) 681- 6703, before 8:30am, to report their absence. Please mention their first/last name and teacher as well as the reason for the absence.

### **Parking**

Reminder there is no parking on D'Arcy McGee on the school side of the street. The city signage indicates no parking from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday. Our school bus needs to pull up to the curb in order to safely unload and load our students.
