### ! Exams

Grade 6 have completed the French exam and are presently writing the Language Arts exam followed by Math. Grades 2 and 4 will be writing school board end of cycle exams. Students have had the opportunity to write a previous year's exam in order to prepare them for this LES (Learning Evaluation Situation). The exams for grade 2 through 4 are not weighted. The exam will be one sample of the evidence collected over the year in order to assess your child's level of competency which is communicated to you via the report card. It is very important that students do not miss class for any non-essential reasons as it is difficult to keep up with all the various tasks.

## **Movement Week- May 14**

In response to the Quebec government mandate 15023 encouraging schools to get their students active for 60 minutes a day, Crestview is launching our own initiative with Movement Week. Although the majority of our students are active, Canadian statistics show that only 9% of 5 to 17 years olds are reaching the daily minimum requirement of 60 minutes moderate to vigorous activity (MVA) a day.

We are pleased to announce that during the week of May 14<sup>th</sup> we are going to run Movement Week, organized by Becky Zucco of OneLife Health and her team. Becky is an experienced exercise physiologist, health educator and mother of three. She has worked for over 24 years in chronic disease rehabilitation and is the founder of OneLife Health offering education, prevention and rehabilitation to those with or concerned by chronic health conditions.

It is important that we educate our students WHY it is important to remain active, balancing technology use and movement as well as INSPIRE them to want to stay active both now and in the future. They are at their most active in primary school, but also developing their intrinsic motivators and habits for life.

In order to ensure the safety of our students the following change, to pick-up, was implemented March 26th.

If you must pick-up your child early, or make a change to their pick-up, it must be written in your child's agenda. If you must make a last-minute change please contact our School Secretary, Ms. Claire,

before 1:00 p.m. Students can no longer be picked up at the office without prior notification. Pick-up after 3:00 p.m. is strongly discouraged.

If your child attends daycare:

Daycare services are from 6:45 a.m. to 8:55 a.m. and from 3:35 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Parents may pick-up their child starting at 4:00 p.m., this will allow the buses to leave and to ensure that all students are accounted for.

If your child is a sporadic daycare user and you require services on an unscheduled day you must speak with Maria Soulis to confirm the change.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation in helping to keep our students learning in a safe environment.



### **Drop-Off in the Morning**

School starts at 9:13 AM. This means that students are entering the school as of 8:55 AM and must be in class by 9:03 AM. The gate being used for student drop-off will continue to be closed at 9:00 AM.

### **Punctuality**

All students are expected to be on time for school every day. When students are late, they miss out on important instruction and it is very disruptive to the teacher and to the other students. Students who arrive late to school must wait at the office until the next period to reduce the disruption.

### **Forgotten items**

Please note that students are not permitted to call home for any forgotten items such as indoor shoes, homework, forms, etc. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate these requests as there are many other important tasks that we must attend to ensure a smooth functioning of the day. The only exception is for a forgotten lunch.



If your child(ren) will be absent from school please call our School Secretary at (450) 681- 6703, before 8:30am, to report their absence. Please mention their first/last name and teacher as well as the reason for the absence.

### **Parking**

Reminder there is no parking on D'Arcy McGee on the school side of the street. The city signage indicates no parking from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday. Our school bus needs to pull up to the curb in order to safely unload and load our students.
