Despite our efforts, we still require approximately \$8000 from the total \$20 000 that we owe for Hope to remain in our school. Our partners at Asista have attested that Hope's impact in our school student life has had a positive impact on the Crestview community. Hagen, a very well-known pet product wholesaler and distributor generously donated their time to create a promotional video featuring Hope and some of the students in our school. During their workday at Crestview, they too were moved by Hope's gentle demeanor and care towards the students. We hope that the promotional video will be released some time early in the summer so stay tuned for that!

Please be reminded of our end-of-day pick-up rules:

If you must pick-up your child early, or make a change to their pick-up, please indicate so in your child’s agenda. If you must make a last-minute change please contact our School Secretary, Ms. Claire, **before 1:00 p.m.** Students can no longer be picked up at the office without prior notification. **Pick-up after 3:00 p.m. is strongly discouraged.**

If your child attends daycare:

Daycare services are from 6:45 a.m. to 8:55 a.m. and from 3:35 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. **Parents may pick-up their child starting at 4:00 p.m.,** this will allow the buses to leave and to ensure that all students are accounted for.

School starts at 9:13 AM. This means that students are entering the school as of 8:55 AM and must be in class by 9:03 AM. The gate being used for student drop-off will continue to be closed at 9:00 AM.
