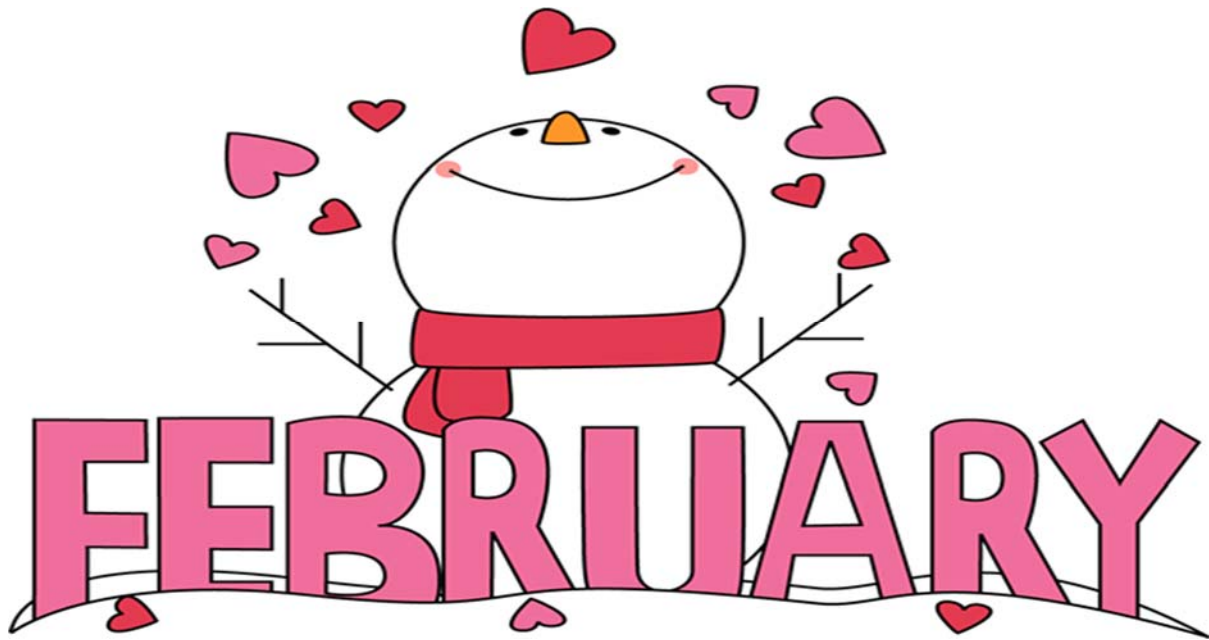


Crestview at a Glance...

- Students are encouraged to wear red, pink or white on Friday!



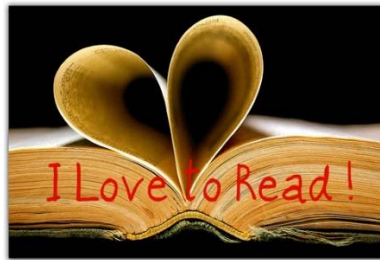
## New Directives
