Good afternoon Crestview Families,

Here are some important points with regard to the government directives for preschool and elementary education.

*Preschool and elementary education:

*Preschool and elementary school students will resume classes on January 11, according to the school calendar.

*Only one stable classroom group at all times without physical distancing measures.

*Students from different stable classroom groups must remain 2 meters apart. Students and staff must remain 2 meters apart. When this is not possible, staff must wear personal protective equipment (PPE). All students must wear face covers at all times in corridors, common areas, and on the school grounds. The use of procedure masks by staff is mandatory. The use by grade 5 and grade 6 students of face covers is mandatory.

*Preschoolers do not have to wear face covers.

*Extracurricular activities are suspended.

*School outings and inter-school activities are suspended.

*Specific pedagogical projects are maintained in stable classroom groups. If impossible, students not from the same stable classroom group must always stay 2 meters apart and health rules must be rigorously observed.

*The loan and rental of school premises are suspended except for childcare service or for the mandataries of specific pedagogical projects.

*All school staff must always wear a procedure mask or a surgical mask in indoor and outdoor common areas.

*Visitors to the school must be kept to a minimum.

*Childcare services must be organized in a spirit of respect for stable classroom groups or sub-groups must be established that observe physical distancing.

*Lunch with students from a stable classroom group.
