Kindergarten Registration and New Students

Registration period **for new students** begins **on January 25, 2021.**

Parents **must call their zoned school to make an appointment** for registration. It is important that you have all required documents with you at the time of registration. Please call the school secretary, Despina Mardas at 450-681-6703 to set up an appointment to register your child at Crestview Elementary School.

Required Documents

- The child's original long version birth certificate bearing parents' names
- A proof of parents' Canadian citizenship
- Two Québec proof of residency (ex. Tax receipt, any utility bill, etc.)
- Child's last report card if attended a school the previous year
- Application for Certificate of Eligibility to English education will be filled out at the school during your appointment
- Some schools may require other documents
- To register for pre-kindergarten, your child must be 4 years of age by September 30. To register for kindergarten, your child must be 5 years of age by September 30.

Covid 19 Update and Reminders

- To make sure that going back to school is as safe as possible for everyone, we remind you not to send your child to school if he or she has flu symptoms (e.g. fever or cough):
- It is imperative that we continue to follow public health directives to help in preventing the spread of Covid 19: Frequent hand washing, face coverings and social distancing etc...)
- **All students must wear face coverings in hallways and common areas.**
- Children in preschool are exempt from this requirement, however at Crestview we will try to encourage all the students to wear face covering in common areas. In addition, masks must be worn when they enter the school building.
- Students in grades 5 and 6 must wear face coverings in the classroom. **This included the gymnasium, therefore during the days your child has physical education we recommend that your child bring in two masks. One that they wear for gym class and one to wear in their regular homeroom class.**

If your child has symptoms of COVID-19, it is recommended that he or she get tested as soon as possible and before going back to school.

Situations for which your child must be kept in isolation:

- a. The child has received a positive test result
- b. The child is waiting to get tested or for a test result
- c. The child has been in contact with a confirmed case
- d. The child has returned from abroad

- Due to the pandemic, changes were made to the Education Act for the school year 2020-2021, therefore, end of term at Crestview, was on January 15, 2021
- Report cards will be available on Mozaik on **February 5, 2021.**
- Second term begins today, January 18, 2021.

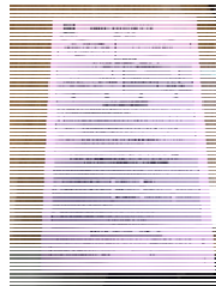
